





# Past Simple - Past Progressive Time Clauses (when, while)



- >> While I was walking down the street, I slipped and fell.
- >>> Beth was chasing Sue on her bike when she crashed into a fence.

#### » Past Simple - Past Progressive Time Clauses (when, while)

We use the Past Progressive and the Past Simple in the same sentence when one action interrupted another in the past. We use the Past Progressive for the longer action and the Past Simple for the shorter action. In this case we usually use while or when.
 While I was driving, I saw a cat on the street.
 I was sleeping when the telephone rang.

#### » NOTE

We use when + Past Simple  $\rightarrow$  Past Simple for actions that happened one after the other in the past.

When I saw the ghost, I ran out of the house.
